Floor Technician Job Summary

Floor Technicians are responsible for delivering specialized cleaning and floor services. They must be capable of assessing the needs of a facility and delivering the proper floor or carpet cleaning services. Floor technicians must be familiar with specialized equipment for floor finish removal and application, carpet extraction, and carpet spotting services. Floor technicians are often scheduled to complete special cleaning projects such as windows, upholstery, and post-construction cleaning.

This position requires a flexible schedule. While primarily scheduled evening shift; days, weekends, and overnight shifts may be required.

- Prior cleaning or janitorial experience required
- Prior experience buffing, stripping, and waxing hard floor surfaces
- Prior experience with cleaning and/or extracting carpets
- Valid driver's license
- Physical stamina
- Attention to detail
- Background check, driving background check, and drug test required
